The PATH Summer Academy is a 5-week program designed to help Arts & Humanities transfer students acclimate to UC San Diego

DATES:

SUMMER SESSION 1: July 1 – August 3, 2019 | Orientation Dinner: Sunday, June 30, 2019

PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- 2 ACADEMIC COURSES (8 credits) taken by all students regardless of individual major
 - o MUS 150 Jazz and the Music of the African Diaspora: Monday/Wednesday 8:00-10:50 a.m.
 - LTCS 165 The Politics of Food: Tuesday/Thursday 11:00-1:50 p.m.
- WEEKLY WORKSHOPS, held weekly after class from 11:30 a.m. -1:30 p.m.
- WEEKLY MEETINGS WITH ASSIGNED PEER MENTORS, scheduled individually
- MEETINGS WITH ADVISORS & FACULTY, scheduled individually
- OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES (Lunch with a Professor, Study Sessions, etc.)

PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE:

- Complimentary tuition, textbooks, on-campus parking, dorm housing & dining dollars for Summer Session 1
- \$3,000 stipend awarded *after* program completion
- Future opportunities for employment as a mentor and more

BY SIGNING THIS CONTRACT, I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM REQUIRED TO:

□ Attend and participate in <u>ALL</u> program components for the entire 5-week program

- o Orientation dinner, classes, field trips, workshops, mentor meetings, faculty and advisor meetings
- Complete and submit all needed paperwork by the deadlines provided
- D Make arrangements with other commitments (e.g. work) in order to attend all program components
- Check my campus email regularly and respond to messages within 48 hours
- □ Schedule weekly meetings with my peer mentor, and complete program worksheet tasks
- Follow both university and residential life policies* including the UC San Diego Principles of Community which serves as a guiding principle to create an inclusive and intellectually vibrant community
- Grant permission to the University to use any photography taken during the academy for marketing purposes
- □ Notify program coordinators (Laura Martin or Joelle Fusaro path@ucsd.edu) *immediately* if:
 - A situation arises that prevents my attendance at a program component **
 - I decide to change or terminate any aspect of my involvement in the program (e.g. move out of dorm housing), and if so, I agree to return any materials provided to me
 - o I feel uncomfortable with my mentor, campus living situation, or any other areas related to the program

** Notice is required in advance of any absence. I understand excessive absences (3+) may result in a loss of program benefits, including my stipend, and that unexcused late arrivals or early departures may constitute an absence.
